Another keyboard will shortly be installed in Telharmonic Hall, on Broadway and 39th street, so that, with additional dynamos and the resultant increase in the number of overtones, or partials—also called harmonics—the telharmonist will be enabled to offer a greater variety of tonal effects, particularly those which correspond to the violin and other stringed instruments. With four players at the keyboards, more complicated music can be produced, and a recital—there being four every day—will be found to be both instructive and enjoyable.

Elliott Schenck is the musical director and his corps of assistants are all very capable musicians.
