N. Y. ELECTRIC MUSIC CO. IN TROUBLE.

One of the companies interested in the Cahill Telharmonic system for dispensing electric music, is in trouble, an execution for \$534 against the New York Electric Music Co. in favor of Jacob P. Muller & Co., advertising agents, having been turned over to the Sheriff's office last week.

When a deputy went to Telharmonic Hall, Broadway and Thirty-ninth street, to make a levy, he found the place locked and deserted, it having been closed several months, ostensibly for the purpose of installing additional machinery.

The system of companies interested in the invention is an elaborate one, comprising five corporations, with capital of nearly \$2,000,000.
